This role is pivotal in driving the success of our mission to help teens, young adults, and families overcome the effects of drugs and alcohol through education and prevention.

#### **Education and Training**

#### **Required**

• Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor (LCDC), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), or equivalent certification.

• The Program Director must have a valid Texas driver license, a minimum of six (6) years of driving experience, a clean driving record, and must be twenty-three (23) years of age or older to comply with Rise Recovery's insurance requirements.

# Knowledge and Experience Required

- Proven experience working with at-risk youth and individuals with substance use disorders.
- Strong leadership skills with experience in managing teams and programs.
- Knowledge of all applicable rules and regulations pertaining to substance use disorder counseling and treatment and/or peer recovery models.
- Breadth of knowledge and extensive practice experience in the delivery and management of recovery services across the continuum of care.
- Fluent in verbal and written communication in English.

#### Preferred

- Experience in data-driven program evaluation.
- Familiarity with community-based recovery models.
- Fluent in both verbal and written communication in Spanish
- Personal or familial experience with long term recovery.
- Breadth of knowledge and extensive practice experience in the delivery and management of recovery services across the continuum of care



## **Skill Competencies**

- Minimum of three (3) year of full-time work experience in the social services or substance use disorder and/or co-occurring services
- Unparalleled passion to serve all people in need of recovery.
- Knowledge of prevailing best practice standards.
- Proficiency with standard Microsoft Office applications.
- Ability to remain calm during stressful situations.
- Excellent written and verbal communications.
- Interpersonal skills, organizing ability, problem solving, accuracy, follow through, time management and attention to detail.
- Ability to travel to meetings and other sites.

## **Physical Requirements**

- Must be able to meet the physical requirements to complete SAMA and CPR training including lifting up to 12 lbs. and supporting up to 55 lbs.; bending, stooping, and getting on and off the floor without assistance.
- Ability to walk, stand, sit for short or long periods of time.
- Prolonged periods of sitting at a desk and working on a computer.
- Able to operate standard office technology, equipment and utilize office supplies.

## **Working Conditions**

- Standard administrative office environment.
- Regularly scheduled hours may vary during periods of workload fluctuation.
- Occasional night, weekend and holiday hours may be necessary to support additional recovery programming and/or Rise Recovery events.
